Fr. William Vos

Speaking: July 19 -20, 2014

Fr. Bill Vos, a Diocesan priest from the Diocese of St. Cloud, Minnesota, will share the story of the Maryknoll Lay Missioners and his own mission experience. Fr. Vos spent 19 years in East Africa with the Maryknoll Lay Missioners. During his time in mission he also served as Africa Regional Coordinator for the Maryknoll Lay Missioners. On returning to his Diocese he was appointed as director of the Diocesan Mission Office and Diocesan Director of Catholic Relief Services. He remains very involved with the Maryknoll Lay Missioners, currently serving as the Chairperson of the Board of Directors.

Fr. Bill Vos will speak at all Masses on July 19 & 20 to share his experience of mission life. The second collection will be taken to support Maryknoll Lay Missioners. Your kind welcome and generous support is most appreciated.

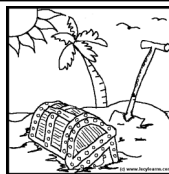
