For the last 3 years Our Lady of the Lake Parish has joined with other local Churches to host an overnight Winter Shelter for our homeless neighbors. The Shelters provide hot meals and a place to sleep that is warm and dry. Last year St. Bridget’s Parish joined with OLL and this winter, Assumption parishioners will have an opportunity to be part of this effort. By the participation of all 3 Parishes the Shelter is able to be open an extra week.
