Divine Mercy-How will you celebrate the Jubilee Year of Mercy?

Pope Francis asks each of us to celebrate the Year of Mercy through action. There are many actions that we might pursue. **Devotions** are one such way. What is devotion? "Devotion involves a decision and a commitment that permeates our lives, giving direction and form to all our actions. Devotions are specific religious attitudes, prayers and practices that express and nurture our total consecration (devotion) to God. They can serve as a witness to others and are also a way of deepening our relationship to God. (Adapted from Marian Press, *The Divine Mercy Message and Devotion*, 1984)
