**Divine Mercy:** There are many ways to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Mercy?

Last week's Faith Formation statement regarding Divine Mercy, introduced Sr. Faustina Kowalska's revelation of Jesus' message of Divine Mercy. However, you might be asking yourself why build my relationship with God through a Devotion. Isn't going to Mass once a week enough? According to the teaching of the apostle, Paul, "...we are encouraged to, "...pray at every opportunity." We know that the life of the Church centers on the liturgy, the official public worship of God by the Body of Christ. Therefore, it is not possible for us to fill us all of our day with participation in the liturgy. Therefore, Devotions became a way to stay connected to God, ways of praying often when not at Mass. In light of the history of the early Church, we can begin to understand that led by scripture devotions came into the life of the Church. How will you show mercy and forgiveness during this Jubilee Year of Mercy? Might you now choose a way to pray without ceasing to God? (Adapted from United States Congress of Catholic Bishops, 2003)
