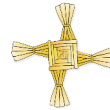

There are many ways to celebrate the Jubilee Year of Mercy!

According to the teaching of the Hebrew Scriptures, the Old Testament, the merciful love of God, is the central theme of the Bible. In the Old Testament, God declares to Moses that He is: "a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness" (Ex 34:6)

In Jesus' revelation to St. Faustina, Jesus said: "Mankind will not have peace until it turns with trust to My mercy"

(St. Faustina's Diary, 300).

How will we show mercy and forgiveness during this Jubilee Year of Mercy? Might we be called to join with others in Parish Guilds to spread God's mercy?

### VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:

#### Parish Guilds:

- **St. Gerard—Holy Family Guild:** We strive to give support to the Parish through Christian fellowship and action through providing assistance with funeral receptions.
- **St. Elizabeth Ann Seaton Guild:** We focus on fostering fellowship between the women of the Parish, as well as supporting the needs of the Parish and the community. Charities the Guild supports: Orion Center, St. Bridget Auction, St. Francis House, and the Purdy Women's Prison (reading initiative for women and babies).

**ADULT FAITH FORMATION:** Advanced registration required for all groups

RCIA, and a Profession of Faith and Adult Confirmation are ways to become fully initiated into the Christian faith through the Catholic tradition.

- **RCIA Inquiry group:** dates to be announced during the month of July.
- **Profession of Faith, already baptized and catechized** attend classes to make a Profession of Faith and be fully initiated into the Catholic Church.
