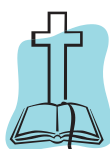

#### The Year of Mercy ends this Sunday, November 20th.

We begin the Liturgical season of Advent on Sunday, November 27th.

We will now be in our Church’s liturgical season of Advent (Advent is a word which comes from, “ad-venire” in Latin meaning “to come to”) A season, which encompasses the four Sundays (and weekdays ) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The Advent season is a time of preparation to focus on Chris’s second coming at the end of time as well as the Anniversary of the Lord’s birth on Christmas. The beginning days in Advent the scripture focus is on the second coming of Christ. The final days of Advent, from Dec.17th—24th, focus predominantly on our preparation for the celebration of the Nativity of our Lord (Christmas).

Advent decorations include the Advent Wreath and Advent Calendar (during all four weeks of the Advent season) and the Jesse Tree (a second week Advent tradition). These devotions serve to remind us of the meaning of the season. Through Advent we are called to fully enter into the season with daily activities and prayer preparing us spiritually for the birth of Jesus Christ.

#### **How will you prepare for Advent?**

Advent supplies including materials to build your own Advent Wreath will be on sale in the Parish hall the next two weeks.
