Funeral Guideline:

When someone dies in the family, please contact Fr. Haydock to set up the time for the funeral. Generally, it is difficult to have a funeral on Saturday. Cemeteries usually charge more for Saturday burials. You will need to meet with Fr. Haydock to discuss the details of the funeral. There is no open casket at the funeral mass. You must use parish musicians. Another person may join the cantor to sing. The final selection of music must be appropriate for a Catholic Mass. If you wish a rosary, you should do it at the funeral home. It is not done prior to the funeral mass.

Eulogies are limited to ten minutes. The time can be divided between several people. Written copies of the eulogies must be turned on the day before the funeral.

The parish is happy to help arrange a reception for you. Please contact Luanne Johnson of the parish staff.

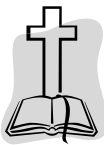
