St. Bridget operates on an approximately \$800,000. each year. To sustain these programs, we ask the level of your support for the coming year.

58 parishioners have told us so far that they will contribute \$146,088. Obviously, this is not sufficient to support the budget. Unlike the federal government, the parish cannot deficit spend.

While I trust in God, I would be irresponsible not to reduce parish services in light of the support the parish is offering. During this past year, we have added several programs to serve the needs of the parish like Youth Ministry. The budget for Youth Ministry is around \$100,000. If you have not filled out a Stewardship card, please do so and return to the parish. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
