St. Bridget volunteers will take over cooking and hosting responsibilities on Feb. 22nd and several parishioners have answered the call either to host or cook. Thank you! All of our cooking slots are filled with dedicated cooks, and all the evening host slots have also been filled.

There are still a couple Morning Host slots open. The **shift time is 5-7:30AM**. Admittedly, this is very dark and early, a real Lenten sacrifice! As a morning host, you'll be setting out the breakfast items, cleaning up the shelter spaced after guests have departed (at 6:30am).
