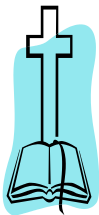
The OLL site will be open:

**JOIN US SUNDAY MORNINGS FOR
CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD**

Children grades K-5 are welcome and encouraged to come to the children's liturgy at every Sunday 10:30 Mass. Children are called forth by Father Okumu at the beginning of Mass.
