Divine Mercy: Pope John Paul II during the Mass for the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska on 23rd of May 2000, proclaimed to the world that on the Second Sunday of Easter beginning with the Jubilee Year 2000, that “from now on throughout the Church this Sunday will be called Divine Mercy Sunday, that is the Second Sunday of Easter. A proclamation granted to the Universal Church by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. The decree stated that throughout the world the Second Sunday of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday, would be a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind will experience in the years to come. These papal acts represent the highest endorsement that the Church can give to a private revelation, an act of papal infallibility proclaiming the certain sanctity of the mystic, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska and granting of a universal feast, as requested by Our Lord to St. Faustina.
