Divine Mercy-

How will you celebrate the Jubilee Year of Mercy?

Another form of devotion was made known to us from the diary of a young Polish sister, Sr. Faustina Kowalska. She revealed a special devotion to the Mercy of God. The message she revealed was nothing new, just a reminder of what the Church has always taught: that God is merciful and forgiving and that we, too, must show mercy and forgiveness. However, what the **Divine Mercy devotion** takes on a powerful new focus. It calls people to a deeper understanding of the fact that God's love is unlimited and available to everyone—especially those in greatest need. Jesus revealed to her that "the greater the sinner, the greater the right she or he has to My mercy." (Adapted from Marian Press, *The Divine Mercy Message and Devotion, 1984*)
