### **Divine Mercy is the out pouring of God's love.**

"We do not have to convince God to be merciful to us because He is Love and Mercy itself" (Diary, 1074). Therefore, "along with the Sacraments, both corporate and personal prayer is essential. There is no soul which is not bound to pray, or else it will fall again: A soul which is pure and beautiful must pray or else it will lose its beauty; a soul which is striving after purity must pray, or else it will never attain it; a soul which newly converted must pray, or else it will fall again; and a sinful soul, plunged in sins, must pray so that it might rise again. (Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, 146)
