The Liturgical Calendar: the Church season we are now in is called Ordinary Time. Ordinary Time begins after Evening Prayer on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord until the day before Ash Wednesday. Ordinary time ceases during Lent and resumes after Evening

Prayer on the Solemnity of Pentecost until the First Sunday of Advent, which begins four Sundays before the Nativity of our Lord, on Christmas. The word Ordinary comes from the word ordinal and means “counted”.

This Sunday is the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time.
