Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist at St. Bridget Parish

In January children in 2nd grade or older whose families belong to St. Bridget Parish will begin preparing for **First Reconciliation**.

Parent meeting for parents from our Faith Formation program, ASB, Villa, and other Public and Private schools will meet with catechists on either **Jan. 21 at 11 AM** or **Jan. 24 at 7 PM**.

Parents choose which meeting works best for their family.

There will be a **parent-child retreat** on **Feb. 10th– 9:30am-1:00pm**,

First Reconciliation will be celebrated Saturday, March 3, 2018 at 10:00am.
