MAKE A MEAL—We'll be providing both dinner and breakfast for approximately 30 people. Consider doing this as a family Lenten Activity, or with fellow parishioners.

ACT AS "HOST" - We'll need two parishioners to be on site to assist the Lake City staffers who will also be present. Your duties include serving and cleaning up after the meal, light housekeeping, and generally providing a welcoming presence to those we serve.

Your can sign up for either the:

Evening shift—7-11:00pm

or the **Morning shift 5-7:30am**

Note that hosts will need to be compliant with the "Safe Environment" requirements of the Archdiocese.

Hosts should also plan on attending the Host orientation meeting offered on Jan 30th (at 8:15 pm) in the shelter space (the Parish Center located across from the church, 3517 NE 89th). Note that these orientations follow the Safe Environment class offered on the same evening.

Miscellaneous: We need a volunteer to take the shelter blankets to the Laundromat once during our week. Also needed is a phone volunteer.
